### WFNS Rabat Training Center Report, 2022-2023

Abdeslam El Khamlichi, MD Director of the Center

The "WFNS Rabat Training Center" (WFNS-RTC) was created in 2002. Two main duties were assigned to the center in the co-operation agreement signed between the WFNS and Mohammed V University Souissi in 2005: the organization of basic training in neurosurgery for young African neurosurgeons granted by the WFNS or other institutions, and organization of courses and workshops as postgraduate training to African neurosurgeons.

## I- ACTIVITY OF THE CENTER IN 2022-2023:

1- New African trainees admitted in the WFNS-RTC (2022-2023):

### a- Basic training:

During the year 2022, fourteen trainees have joined the Center: Doctor Omar Boladji Adebayo Badirou from Benin (UHC of Rabat since April 13, 2022), Doctor Elias Dimaria Opio from Uganda (UHC of Rabat since May 12, 2022), Doctor Mohamed Abdirahman Dirie from Somalia (UHC of Casablanca since May 16, 2022), Doctor Daniel Yamba Yamba from the DRC (UHC of Fez since May 30, 2022), Doctor Arnold Mukowa Mukendi from the DRC (UHC of Marrakech since June 1, 2022), Doctor Yahya Said Farah from Somalia (UHC of Rabat since June 6, 2022), Doctor Christian Nyangezi Kassole from the DRC (UHC of Marrakech since June 6, 2022), Doctor Audrick Kasonga from the DRC (UHC of Marrakech since June 7, 2022), Doctor Zeus Mala Nganziamu from the DRC (UHC of Marrakech since June 20, 2022), Doctor Victor Mutumbo Ntumba from the DRC (UHC of Marrakech since June 20, 2022), Doctor Baba Alhaji Bin AlHassan from Ghana (UHC of Rabat since July 26, 2022), Doctor Emeka Alfred Clement from Nigeria (UHC of Rabat since August 10, 2022), Doctor Peter Pastory Kyombya from Tanzania (UHC of Rabat since October 13, 2022), and Doctor Rosina Twumwaa Gyamera from Ghana (UHC of Rabat since October 19, 2022) have begun a 5-year training.

During the year 2023, eight trainees have joined the Center: Doctor Joris Uriel Mahussi Adjoglo from Benin (UHC of Rabat since April 5, 2023), Doctor Oswald Niyongere from Burundi (UHC of Fez since April 14, 2023), Doctor Peter Abdul Bangura from Sierra Leone (UHC of Rabat since June 19, 2023), Doctor Allieu Kamara from Sierra Leone (UHC of Rabat since June 19, 2023), Doctor François Imani Hamuli from the DRC (UHC of Rabat since June 19, 2023), Doctor Ulysse Uwimana from Burundi (UHC of Rabat since July 3, 2023), Doctor Zunis Ombilingo Saidi from the DRC (UHC of Rabat since July 4, 2023), Doctor Yakhouba Fofana from Guinea Conakry (UHC of Rabat since October 12, 2023), have begun a 5-year training.

- All these trainees are well-integrated in the residency program of the university, working in rotation with the Moroccan residents between the nine departments of neurosurgery at University hospitals in Rabat, Casablanca, Fez, and Marrakech.
- They sit with the Moroccan residents for the same examination every year, and for the final examination to achieve the National Diploma of Specialization in Neurosurgery at the end of the fifth year.
- They have access to the Medical School Library and E-Learning.
- At the hospital, the residents share the same activities with the Moroccan residents in terms of clinical care, emergency room duties, and operating room program.

# 4- Financial support of the trainees currently in the Center:

The scholarships of twelve trainees are granted as a scholarship. The twenty-five remaining trainees live by their own means:

- Twenty-five trainees (Doctors I. Mahazou Abdou from Niger, J. Dimbi Makoso from the DRC, H.G. Turpin from Guinea Conakry, A. Djimrabeye from Chad, Y. Diakite from Guinea Conakry, Y.C.H.P. Dokponou from Benin, L.P.P.Kapongo from the DRC, N. Imbunh from Guinea Bissau, F.L. Ontsi Obame from Congo Brazzaville, F.D.K.D. Adjiou from Togo, M.Y. Moune from Cameroon, L.M.P.
